35. You agree that you will not give an interview or write about your PPS experiences without the express and written consent of PPS.

36. All evidence collected in any form is the property of the Pensacola Paranormal Society.

37. You agree to a criminal background check.

38. Missing or damaged items (by a client, PPS or service vender) could potentially result in your responsibility for repair and/or replacement costs.

39. We reserve the right to change the conditions of membership and to make changes to this contract without explanation or notice to the Volunteer. Changes to this contract will void the original contract making it necessary for the Volunteer to sign a new contract upon her/his review and acceptance of the new terms. Such acceptance is of course voluntary, but required for participation in PPS.

40. You agree that the following are true about you:

- (1) 21 years or older.
- (2) No criminal background.
- (3) No history of mental problems.
- (4) Have a job or a steady source of income.
- (5) Not on any medication that may cause hallucinations or impair judgment.
- (6) Not treated for manic depression, schizophrenia, hallucinations, personality disorders, alcoholism, drug addictions, or treated for any other medical condition that may endanger yourself or other team members.
- (7) Must be honest.
- (8) Use of dark energy, invocation spells, or any other form magick that has not been approved by PPS is strictly prohibited.

41. Failure to disclose any of the above (affirmations identified in clause #40) may result in termination from PPS and the Volunteer will be obligated for all fees encountered by lawsuit for breach of trust not including lawsuit by client and that you will pay for all court costs.

42. We reserve the right to terminate any Volunteer who interferes with an investigation or the operations of PPS, with all such determinations being made by the controlling officers of PPS or their appointee. We reserve the right to make such determinations subjectively and without expressing specific cause.

43. Individuals desiring to participate in the Pensacola Paranormal Society do so of their own free will and at their own risk.

44. In the event of any injury, Volunteers must accept individual responsibility for the full expense of medical attention as well as any other expenses arising out of such injury. Some Volunteer projects may have inherent risks associated with them, and it is the Volunteer's responsibility to

know what those risks are and to not follow through on any activity that they deem too high a level of risk for their own capabilities.

Volunteers agree to release and hold the Pensacola Paranormal Society, The Light Spiritual Education Ministries, The Light Wellness Center, and All One Spirit, its officers, agents, employees as well as the owners/caretakers of the subject properties and PPS clients under investigation harmless from and against all losses, claims or liabilities for personal damages or other damages incurred as a result of their participation in PPS.
